In exercise of powers conferred by Section 5 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Act No. 63 of 1948), the Administrator of Union Territory, Chandigarh hereby orders that all the factories registered under the Factories Act, 1948 in Union Territory, Chandigarh shall be exempted from the provisions of Section 51 (weekly hours), Section 54 (daily hours), Section 55 (intervals for rest) and Section 56 (spreadover) with immediate effect for a period of three months subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) No worker shall be allowed or required to work in a factory for more than twelve hours in any day and seventy two hours in any week.
- (ii) The periods of work of workers in a factory each day shall be so fixed that no period shall exceed six hours and that no worker shall work for more than six hours before he has had an interval for rest of at least half an hour.
- (iii) No Female worker shall be allowed or required to work in a factory between 07:00 PM to 06:00 AM.

Other provisions of the Factories Act, 1948 shall continue to be in force.
