In the letter read above, the Director of Drugs Control has stated that the following 12 services of that department are implemented through e-Sevai Centres / e-Sevai Portal maintained by Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency, Chennai.

Sales Services

1. Application for grant of licence of allopathic drugs (Sales)
2. Application for grant/renewal of licence of Homeopathic Medicines (Sales)
3. Application for grant of licence of restricted allopathic drugs (Sales)
4. Application of grant of licence of Schedule X drugs (Sales)
5. Application for issue of duplicate licence (Sales)

Manufacturing services

6. Grant of licence for manufacture of drugs- Allopathy (Except licences requiring central licence approving authority's approval)
7. Approval of additional categories of products
8. Grant of repacking licence for allopathic drugs
9. Change of technical persons in the licences

10. Grant/renewal of licence for manufacture of drugs - Homeopathy.
11. Grant of loan licence for manufacture of drugs - Allopathy (Except licences requiring central licence approving authority's approval)
12. Grant of Test licence.

2. The Director of Drugs Control has further stated that in order to comply the reform conditionalities of Government of India for availing the additional borrowing of 2% of GDSP by the State Government and also to comply Business Reform Action Plan 2020 of DPIIT of Government of India, an automated, non discretionary system for renewal of licences, i.e an online application for payment of licence retention fees for drugs sales and manufacturing licences have been developed by Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency (TNeGA), Chennai and the TNeGA will enable the following online services on 31 October 2020.


