Important guidelines in case of switchover of trading system to Disaster Recovery (DR) Site

In pursuance of SEBI guidelines for Business Continuity Plan (BCP) and Disaster Recovery (DR) of Market Infrastructure Institutions (MIIs) specified in the SEBI circular SEBI/HO/MRD1/DTCS/CIR/P/2021/33 dated March 22, 2021, this is to inform that NSE trading system provides high availability of its services by having identical setup available at NSE DR site.

In case of contingency observed at the primary site, the Exchange may have to shift its operation from primary site to DR site. It is necessary that in such event necessary action shall be taken at member's end to bring their systems into a consistent state.

Members may note that no changes are required to be made at their end for connecting to Primary/DR site for Order Matching Platform, Negotiated Trade Reporting Platform & Tri-Party Repo Market Platform and the same URL as mentioned below shall be used for login:

NDM Order-matching Platform:

1. Exchange shall not carry forward outstanding orders from primary site to DR site and no cancellation messages shall be sent for these orders
2. Trades of primary site shall be available in "Trade Book" Tab at DR site
3. In case the updates carried out in user master at primary site is not available at DR site, then the member admin needs to re-initiate the said updates at DR site

Tri-party Repo Order-matching Platform:

1. Exchange shall not carry forward outstanding orders from primary site to DR site and no cancellation messages shall be sent for these orders
2. Trades of primary site shall be available in "Trade Book" Tab at DR Site
3. In case the updates carried out in user master at primary site is not available at DR site, then the member admin needs to re-initiate the said updates at DR site

Negotiated Trade Reporting Platform:

1. Trades reported at primary site shall be available in "Trades" Tab at DR site
2. Members shall require to re-initiate reporting of trades / trade modification / trade cancellation requests raised at PDC site for which the updates are not available at DR site

3. In case the updates carried out in user master at primary site is not available at DR site, then the member admin needs to re-initiate the said updates at DR site

The changes shall be effective in the live environment with effect from June 21, 2021.
