The following para is added after para 5 ii e.

f. The individual farmer will be eligible to purchase irrigation pump by availing 'At Source Subsidy Facility'. In such case, the subsidy shall be paid to the dealer provided farmer pays his/her share of cost (cost price minus subsidy) to the dealer and also furnishes Letter of Authority to that effect. All such cases shall require prior approval of the concerned Zonal Agriculture Officer.

The farmer has to purchase the pump set only from the valid dealer registered with Directorate of Agriculture if he/she wants to avail assistance under the scheme both by availing 'At Source' subsidy facility and by direct purchasing the pumpset from the dealer at full cost.

Other contents of the notification remain the same. This addendum shall come into force with immediate effect.

The 1st para of Notification is replaced and shall be read as:

Western Ghat Development Programme is under operation in the State of Goa in five Talukas viz. Sanguem, Quepem, Canacona and Dharbandora in South Goa District and Sattari in North Goa District for the development of ecological fragile areas. The following modified State Sector scheme 'Western Ghat Development Programme' approved by the Government of Goa is hereby published for general information of the public.

Clause 3 Eligibility

Clause 4 Pattern of Assistance 4.4 Conservation Programme

ii, is replaced and shall be read as:

Assistance shall be provided for Digging of Crescent Shape Trenches of dimension 1.5 mtr x 0.4 mtr at a distance of 1 to 2 mtr from plant on upper side of the slope @ Rs. 65/- per trench. A single beneficiary may open upto 1000 trenches with prior approval.

iv. (a) is replaced and shall be read as: Bank Stabilization work of 1.0 mtr height with foundation of 0.6 mt (w) x 0.3 mtr. (D) shall be Rs. 1003/- per RM.

(b) is replaced and shall be read as:

Bank Stabilization work of 1.5 mt height with foundation of 0.8 mt (w) x 0.5 mt (D) shall be Rs. 1948/- per RM.

(c) is replaced and shall be read as:

Bank stabilization work of 2.0 mt height with foundation of 1.0 mt (w) x 0.6 mt (D) shall be Rs. 2814/- per RM.

Community Dairy Farming Scheme (Amended 2021)

Introduction.— Government has noticed that the small units of around 10 cow dairy farms are not much profitable to take up as a business entrepreneur. The farmers with limited land holding also find it difficult to expand the existing units due to scarcity of land and other infrastructure requirements. After going through the feasibility of the schemes, a concept of community dairy farming has been under consideration for long

time to facilitate group of people coming together with a common intention to take up dairy farming on a community basis with common infrastructure support.

Therefore it is proposed to encourage such Community Dairy farming with minimum 50 milch animals and with latest ultra modern dairy equipments such as milk parlour, milk cooler and feed mixing plant etc. which can be availed by community group of minimum 5 members.

Objectives.— (1) To encourage larger Dairy units by farmers/groups to have dairy farming activities at a common place i.e. Community Group with minimum five unrelated members.

(2) To reduce the cost of production by sharing the infrastructure facilities like cattle shed, milk parlour, bulk milk cooler and feed mixing plant.

(3) To encourage farmers/Community groups to take up dairy business as an industry.

(4) To make the State self sufficient in milk production.

(5) To generate self employment to the unemployed youth.

(6) To provide clean and hygienic milk to the consumers of State of Goa.

Eligibility.— (1) Any group having minimum 5 members and registered with competent authority (Registrar of Co-operative Society).

(2) May desirably possess irrigated land for Green Fodder Cultivation or use other alternatives like silage, hydroponic etc. as a source of fodder, in addition to the area for infrastructure developments of minimum 10000 sq. mts.

(3) The scheme is applicable for new unit and expansion of the existing Community Dairy.

(4) Each member of the group shall be resident of Goa for at least preceding five years, with experience in dairy management/practical training for 15 days in dairy management.

Documents to be produced.— The full fledged project report of the proposed unit along with the following required documents.

(i) Documents indicating the ownership of land in Form No. I & XIV/Sale deed or copy of notarized lease deed or legitimized NOC from land owner for a period of 12 years.

(ii) NOC and construction license from prescribed authority.

(iii) Certificate of registration of the group from competent authority (Registrar of Co-operative Society).

(iv) Letter from the Financing Institution having ECS system, willing to finance the beneficiary.

(v) Residence Certificate of each member issued by competent authority (preceding 05 years).

(vi) Consent for seeding and authentication of Aadhar/UID number.

(vii) Certificate of practical training in dairy management (of all the members).

(viii) Passport size photograph of each applicant.

(ix) Survey site plan/plan of the cattle shed, store room and other infrastructure proposed at the said unit of community dairy.

(x) Notarised authority from group members to the leader of the group.

(xi) Annexure showing the details of the group members.

Procedure for application.— The Group interested in availing this Scheme will have to apply in a prescribed application form through Area Assistant Director/Veterinary Officer along with a non-refundable processing fee of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only).

Detailed guidelines of the scheme.— (1) The scheme intends to promote Dairy farming as an Industry and to provide self-employment to the youth by assisting the interested community Groups, desirous in establishing a Dairy Farm, wherein the Group can buy Cross Bred Cows/Improved She Buffaloes/

/Indigenous breed of cows namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi, Rathi, Tharparkar.

(2) The Group should be registered with competent authority (Registrar of Co-operative Society).

(3) The eligible applicant Group should complete the sanctioned project in all respects within one year of sanction.

(4) Purchase of Milch animals shall be allowed only after completion of the infrastructure of the proposed farm in all respect.

(5) Fodder cultivation is desirable and farmer is free to opt for alternatives for green fodder viz. silage, hydroponic etc. or also can purchase green fodder on regular basis.

(6) Milch animals under the scheme have to be necessarily purchased from Cattle Mela held at Government Livestock Farms or from outside the State. Transit insurance is mandatory in case the animals are purchased from outside the State.

(7) Unit cost of Cross Bred Cow/Improved She Buffalo/Indigenous breed cows namely Sahiwal, Gir and Red Sindhi, Rathi, Tharparkar shall be limited to Rs. 70,000/- per animal expected to yield 2700 liters of milk per lactation for the purpose of release of subsidy.

(8) The animals purchased under the scheme should be insured for a minimum period of 42 months and identification has to be done by microchipping/eartagging system. In the event of unfortunate death of the animals within one month from the date of purchase, beneficiary has to report it in writing to the Area Officer within 24 hrs. of the death. Pursuant to the confirmation and verification of the death by the said Officer and on satisfying the Officer that the death is not due to negligence on the part of the beneficiary, the cost of the animal shall be directly credited to the account of beneficiary group.

(9) After completion of the unit Area, Veterinary Officer/Asst. Director shall submit relevant documents as required under the

scheme to the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, through the Financing Institution.

(10) Agreement bond sworn before Notary/Magistrate on stamp paper as per rule in force, in prescribed format has to be submitted for release of subsidy.

(11) The area Veterinary Officer/Asst. Director shall inspect and submit the report of the infrastructural work. If satisfied, may recommend purchase of milch animals sanctioned under the scheme if not undertaking green fodder Cultivation then an undertaking from the Beneficiary Group that they will produce/procure Silage, Hydroponic green fodder or green fodder from outside agencies.

Terms and Conditions.— The subsidy will be released only after completion of unit in all respects. The following documents are required for release of subsidy.

(1) Bills/Voucher pertaining to construction of cattle shed, cow dung pit, store room, and other infrastructure as applied by the applicant along with the valuation certificate from authorized valuer, duly certified by area Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director.

(2) Cash receipts in original from authorized dealer of the equipments & machinery.

(3) Purchase receipts of milch animals along with transport receipts, health certificate, purchase statement duly certified by Area Veterinary Officer/Assistant Director.

(4) Document showing insurance of milch animals for 42 months from authorized insurance company.

(5) First installment of Subsidy will be released after the purchase of 50 animals for the completed unit in all aspects and after inspection by the Departmental Committee. The subsidy amount shall be credited by ECS mode to the account of the beneficiary group. In case the said beneficiary group desires to incorporate more number of animals with proportionate increase in infrastructure at a later stage they may be permitted to do so with prior approval of the Department. Corresponding subsidy for such additional unit will be released as per the guidelines of the scheme.

The beneficiary Community group should run the unit for a minimum period of 10 years. An agreement in this regard is to be signed by the beneficiary Community Group with the Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Panaji, Goa.

Plant, Machinery and Milch Animals.— Subsidy limited to maximum of Rs. 1.75 crore at the rate of 50% of permissible unit cost (component wise). Transport cost of animals and Insurance Premium will be given 100% of unit cost.

1. Cattle shed	270 sq. mtrs. carpet area for 50 animals. Proportionate increase by 50 animals is allowed subject to the maximum ceiling of 200 animals. The cost limit for the purpose of subsidy is Rs. 6000/- per sq. mtr. Or The loose housing system in Dairy is permitted with 270 sq. mtrs. carpet area for 50 animals. Proportionate increase by 50 animals is allowed. The maximum cost limit for the purpose of subsidy is Rs. 6000/- per sq. mtr. for cattle shed for which it is entitled for subsidy and for open area (Paddock) between 80 to 200 sq. ft. per animal, will not be entitled for subsidy.
2. Cow dung pit	90 cubic mtrs. cow dung pit for 50 animals, proportionate increase in size is allowed depending upon the number of animals. Maximum cost limit is Rs. 2500/- per cubic meter.

3. Community Store room	80 sq. mtrs. carpet area for 50 animals, proportionate increase is allowed depending upon the number of animals. Maximum cost limit is Rs. 6000 per sq. mtr.
4. Cost of Milch animals	Maximum unit cost limit is Rs. 70,000/- per milch animals. Cross bred cows, Improved she buffaloes and cows of Indigenous breeds namely Sahiwal, Gir & Red Sindhi, Rathi, Tharparkar only shall be allowed to be purchased under the scheme.
5. Transport Cost of animals	Rs. 800/- per animal if purchased from Cattle Mela at Government Farms. Rs. 2000/- per animal if purchased from outside the State.
6. Community Bulk Milk Cooler	Bulk Milk Cooler having capacity of minimum 3000 liters. Maximum unit cost being 10,00,000/- including accessories and installation.
7. Community Milk Parlour	Milk Parlour of 8 points costing Rs. 20,00,000/- including installation charges.
8. Generator Set 20 KVA	Generator set of 20 KVA to run both milking parlour & bulk milk cooler. Maximum unit cost limit Rs. 7,00,000/-.
9. Feed Mixing Plant	Feed mixing plant/TMR unit having capacity of minimum 1000 Kg. feed per day. Maximum unit cost limit Rs. 10,00,000/-.
10. Other Dairy Equipments	Total unit cost of Dairy Equipments for 50 Cross Bred Cows amounting Rs. 7,11,850/- Proportionate increase is allowed depending upon number of animals. List of dairy equipments as per Annexure I.
11. Insurance Premium	Milch Animals Insurance premium maximum of Rs. 16,625/- per animal for 42 months life cover of the unit cost of animal mentioned at Sr. No. 4.

4. The animals shall be maintained properly in good health, with proper arrangement of shelter, feed and fodder, proper records of milk, breeding etc.
5. The animals shall not be sold until completion of a period of three and half years (42 months) from the date of purchase of milch animals as per terms and conditions of the scheme. Sufficient replacement of the milch animals shall be made to run the Unit for a minimum period of 10 years with full sanctioned animal strength.

6. The bounder agrees that the equipments are purchased as per the existing rules of the scheme and from only the dealers registered with the Department and all formalities have been carried out before the purchase of farm equipments.
7. The equipments shall be maintained properly in the Community Dairy Unit and made available at all times for inspection by the Officer, from the Department of Animal Husbandry.
8. The equipments shall not be sold, transferred to any person or persons until completion of a period of 10 years from the date of release of subsidy as per the terms and conditions of scheme.
9. Green Fodder requirement/alternative arrangements/use of silage/Hydroponic shall be fulfilled for a minimum period of ten years.

**“Scheme to provide unused Schools’
Land and Buildings to the Non-Profit
Institutions and Social Organizations”**

1. *Preface.*—

1.1 The Department of Education, Government of Goa with an ambition of 100% literacy opened schools in every nook and corner of the State. With the improved transportation, people moved to towns and cities for better facilities, including education. Such migration lowered enrolment in many rural areas that led to closure of many schools.

1.2 Closure of schools led to deterioration of its buildings. On the other hand many non-profit social organizations have been approaching the Government for allotment of such vacant premises for carrying out their social activities. It is felt necessary that such unoccupied buildings and its premises may be made available to the non profit institutions engaged in social, educational, economical, sports and cultural activities. This step will also ensure that the buildings are maintained in good condition and land is protected from encroachment.

2. *Objectives.*— The main objectives of the scheme are as follows:—

- a. To provide for better use of the unused school premises.
- b. To provide infrastructural support to the registered non profit educational institutions for running the institution.
- c. Provision of friendly and conducive space for conducting social, educational, economical and cultural activities.
- d. To alleviate the problem of accommodation and associated problems faced by registered educational institutions.

3. *Eligibility.*— The eligibility conditions and the process to apply under the scheme:

a. All registered non-profit Institutions and social organizations (NGO) registered under the Societies Registered Act, 1860 or Indian Trust Act or under any Act of Parliament or Assembly of Goa or approved by GoG specifically being eligible for the purpose of this scheme.

b. The registered non-profit Institutions shall submit applications under the scheme in prescribed Proforma along with supporting documents.

c. The registered non-profit Institutions shall be in existence and engaged in the activities in the State of Goa for a minimum period of 05 (five) years except for those that are formed through statutory provisions and with GoG’s specific approvals.

d. The institution propagating religious activity or professing any particular religious ideas will not be considered.

e. The institution should function in a democratic manner and as per the approved bye-laws or the applicable statutory provisions of the law. The Managing Committee of the institution should have been elected by following free, fair and transparent election procedure to the satisfaction of the Government. This shall however not be applicable to statutory bodies, which shall follow the relevant statutory provisions.

f. The institutions applying for allotment of Government land for the purpose for creating the additional infrastructure on the school premises shall be financially sound to incur the cost of the proposed infrastructure on the allotted premises and subsequent maintenance of the same. For this purpose, a certificate from a registered Chartered Accountant indicating availability of funds equal or more than 50% of proposed expenditure, with the institution shall be submitted.

g. The institutions applying for the allotment of unused school building or land

shall be financially sound to incur the cost of maintenance of the school building and premise. The applicant shall submit a recent bank statement indicating the bank balance of a minimum of Rs 1,00,000 (Rupees one lakh only) along with the proposal.

h. The institutions shall be active in cultural/social/educational/sports or other related activities as per its aims and objectives.

i. The institutions shall have properly maintained all the statutory or otherwise required records/documents up-to-date.

j. The institutions shall submit a statement of its accounts for the past 3 years, and duly audited by the Chartered Accountant. However, this may be waived off in case of the statutory bodies or by a specific order to that effect by the Government.

4. *Additional Terms and Conditions.*—

a. The scheme provides for allotment of the vacant schools' land and/or buildings belonging to the Department of Education, on leave and license basis to eligible non profit institutions for a term of upto 30 years, that can be further extendable at the discretion of the Government.

b. The allotment on land/buildings will be done on leave and license basis as per recommendation of the committee and with the approval of the Government on a case to case basis.

c. The institutions, after allotment, shall be responsible for incurring any expenditure towards the maintenance, creation of any additional infrastructure, or payment of all the fees and taxes.

d. The grantee institution shall also be responsible to apply for the plans/estimates/permissions, to the appropriate authorities, as required for any development, in the name of the Directorate of Education, with the prior approval of the Director of Education.

e. The Government may allot:

i. Land along with the building.

ii. Rooms or buildings with sound structural condition may require minor repairs.

iii. Rooms or buildings with dilapidated condition may require major repairs.

f. The license fee towards use of the good condition buildings will be Rs. 200/- p.m. and Rs. 50/- p.m for the buildings in dilapidated condition.

g. In cases of e(i) and e(ii) above, the allottee will be required to pay in advance the license fee of 05 years. In case of e(iii), the allottee will be required to pay in advance the total license fee amount of 30 years.

h. Government reserves the right to increase the license fee at regular intervals, if deemed fit. The notice of such increase will be given to the allottee and allottee will have to pay such increased license fee or vacate the premises.

i. In the event the grantee institution is asked to vacate and handover the premises to the Government, the grantee institution shall not claim any compensation or amount towards renovation or repairs incurred by it.

j. In all the circumstances, the Government shall have a preferential right to use the school premises either temporarily or permanently. In either case, the Director of Education will inform the allottee seven days in advance. The period of advance notice shall not be applicable in exceptional/emergency cases.

k. The allottee is not allowed to sublet the premises.

l. The allottee shall not put the premises for any other use, without a prior written permission of the Government.

m. The grantee institution shall enter into an agreement with the Director of Education.

n. The Institution will be permitted to vacate the premises/land allotted upon serving 3 months notice to the Director of Education, and after the notice period the premises/land shall be handed back without any encumbrances.

o. Termination Clause: The Government shall be at liberty to terminate the agreement/allotment at any time, if it is found that the institution concerned has violated the terms and conditions of the scheme and has indulged in any unfair and illegal practices. Due notice of 30 days shall be issued to the concerned party, and will be given an opportunity for personal hearing.

p. The institution applying for allotment under this scheme, for the purpose for creating infrastructure, shall give proof of it being financially sound to incur cost of the proposed infrastructure and its subsequent maintenance. For this purpose, a certificate from a registered Chartered Accountant indicating availability of funds equal or more than 50% of proposed expenditure, with the institution shall be submitted.

5. *Selection Procedure.*— The Directorate of Education shall issue a Public Notice in the local newspaper seeking applications under the scheme from time to time. The applications so received shall be then scrutinized on a case to case basis for allotment of any building/premise as detailed under 4(e).

1. The Directorate of Education shall also seek the requirements of building space/land from the other Government Departments and autonomous bodies.

2. Priority shall be given to Government Department and autonomous bodies for allotment of building or land. The allotment shall be done on case to case basis with the approval of the Government. There is no need to apply by the Govt. Departments and autonomous bodies under this scheme.

3. The proposal received from non-profit institutions and social organization shall be placed before the High Powered Committee consisting of following members for the purpose of selection and recommendation of the institutions for the allotment of unused and vacant Government land as the case may be, to the eligible institutions/organizations.

- a) Education Minister — Chairman
- b) Secretary (Finance) — Member
- c) Secretary (Education)— Member
- d) Secretary (Revenue) — Member
- e) Director (Education) — Member
Secretary.

4. The recommendation of the High Powered Committee shall be placed before the Government and the Hon'ble Chief Minister for approval.

6. *Relaxation.*— The Government is empowered to relax any or all clauses or conditions of the scheme in genuine cases for allotment of land/building except clause 4 (c) of the scheme.

7. *Interpretation.*— If any questions arise regarding interpretation of any, clause, word, expression of the scheme, the decision shall lie with the Government, whose decision shall be final and binding on all concerned.

8. *Redressal of grievances and dispute.*— Grievances, if any, arising out of the implementation of this scheme shall be heard and decided by the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the decision of the Hon'ble Chief Minister in this regard shall be final and binding on all concerned.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the existing recruitment rules for the post of Dean, Goa Dental College and Hospital, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 41, dated 10-01-1991, vide Government Notification No. 1/4/81-PER dated 28-08-1990, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Goa General Service, Group 'A', Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post, in the Goa Dental College and Hospital, Government of Goa, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Goa Dental College and Hospital, Group 'A', Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post, Recruitment Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.
