Essential Commodities Act, 1955 No. GTH/2021/11/ECA/102010/839231/B: In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), read with the Order of the Government of India, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, No. S.O.2674 (E), dated the 2nd July, 2021, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following Order further to amend the Gujarat Essential Articles (Licensing, Control and Stock Declaration) Order 1981, namely:-

- 1. (1) This Order may be called the Gujarat Essential Articles (Licensing, Control and Stock Declaration) (Amendment) Order, 2021.
- (2) It extends to the Whole of the State of Gujarat.
- (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. In the Gujarat Essential Articles (Licensing, Control and Stock Declaration) Order, 1981. (hereinafter referred as "the Said order"), in clause 3 in sub-clause (1), in table for the entry at Sr. No. 4, the following entry shall be substituted namely;-

4	All Pulses put together (except Moong) for a period upto 31st October, 2021	 Wholesaler: 200 MT (subject to condition that there should not be more than 100 MT of one variety) Retailer: 5 MT Millers: Stock limits will be last 3 months production or 25% of annual installed capacity, whichever is higher. Importers: Stock limit applicable to wholesaler will also apply to importers for stocks held in stock / imported prior to 15th May 2021. For stocks imported after 15th May 2021, stock limit applicable to wholesaler, will apply after 45 days from the date of customs clearance.

3. In the Said Order, in Schedule 1, in part I, under the heading "Food Stuffs", after entry A, the following entry shall be inserted, namely:-

" B. All Pulses put together (except Moong)"
