All objections and/or suggestions to the said draft Rules may be forwarded to the Secretary (Factories and Boilers), Government of Goa, Secretariat, Porvorim, before the expiry of said period of sixty days so that they may be taken into consideration at the time of finalization of the said draft Rules.

DRAFT RULES

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Boilers Act, 1923 (Act 5 of 1923) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa Boiler Rules, 1983, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Boiler (Fifth Amendment) Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of rule 8.*— In rule 8 of the Goa Boiler Rules, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Rules”), in sub-rule (2), in clause (a), for the expression “a register in Form A of the rules of all boilers registered in the Union territory of the registry of which has been transferred from another State; the expression “a register in Form A of all boilers registered in the State or the registry of which has been transferred from another State”, shall be substituted.

3. *Amendment of Form B.*— In Form ‘B’ of the Principal Rules,-

(i) for the expression “Indian Boilers Act, 1923”, the expression “The Boilers Act, 1923” shall be substituted;

(ii) for the expression “Steam Boiler Inspection office”, the expression “Boiler Inspection office” shall be substituted;

(iii) for the expression “Chief Inspector of Steam Boilers Goa”, the expression

“Chief Inspector of Boilers, Goa” shall be substituted.

Scheme for promotion of biogas plants in cattle farm, piggery farm and poultry farm based on “cattle dung, pig dung and poultry litter” in the State of Goa

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (i) This scheme may be called as “Incentives” Scheme to set up “Biogas plant based on cow dung, pig dung and bird droppings from poultry for generation of cooking gas and organic manure.

(ii) The generated gas shall be supplied to nearby houses for domestic cooking purpose/commercial/or any other appropriate purpose.

(iii) It shall come into force with immediate effect.

(iv) The scheme shall be implemented through Department of New and Renewable Energy (DNRE).

(v) GEDA shall be responsible to supply generated gas to nearby households/farm/owners commercial/self consumption at Farms or generated gas may be used for any other appropriate purpose.

2. *Introduction to the scheme.*— (i) Government of Goa intends to launch the scheme for promoting “Biogas Plant based on cow dung, piggery dung and poultry litter” and desires to extend its support for waste management at source and promote utilization of Natural Source of Energy in the form of Biogas and provide hygienic, sustainable method of disposal. Promotion of “Biogas Plant” will not only manage daily
