It is informed that the Ministry of Home Affairs has implemented the "Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Center (14C) Scheme" with the objective of providing an effective mechanism to deal with cyber crime in a coordinated and comprehensive manner. "National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal" www.cybercrime.gov.in has been launched for reporting all types of cyber crimes especially cyber crimes against women and children. The incidents reported in the portal are automatically forwarded online to the State/UT concerned.

The Central Government has taken several steps to spread awareness on the prevention of cyber crime. Your cooperation is expected in the fight against cyber crime.

Therefore, you are requested to create awareness about the steps taken by the Government to deal with cyber crime; especially about the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal and the National Helpline No. 1930.
