Whereas vide Notification No. 6-2-2020-RD II/950 dated 23rd October, 2020 issued by Under Secretary (Revenue-II), Revenue Department, Secretariat, Porvorim-Goa published in the Official Gazette on 5th November, 2020, in exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (bb) of Section 2 of the Goa Public Moneys (Recoveries of Dues) Act, 1986, the Government of Goa appointed the PHE Executive Engineer as Recovery Officer of Division III, IX, XII, XVII, XX, XXIV, PWD to exercise and perform all the powers and functions of a Collector under the said Act, in respect of recovery of dues towards water bills and sewerage bills payable to the Public Works Department, Government of Goa.

Now, therefore the Executive Engineer III, IX, XVII, XX, XXIV, PWD to exercise and perform all the powers and functions of a Collector under the said Act, in respect of recovery of dues towards water bills and sewerage bills payable to the Public Works Department, Government of Goa and the same shall be taken up on the last working day of every month between- 3 p.m to 5 p.m and the concerned Assistant Engineer (Revenue) shall assist the Executive Engineer for this purpose.

And the Superintending Engineer-V and VIII, PWD shall ensure continuous monitoring of the action taken up the respective Executive Engineer and a Monthly Report shall be submitted to the Government i.e Hon'ble Minister (PWD) on or before 10th of every month.

Whereas the water supply tariff to all the categories of the consumers are to be billed as per Notification No. 8-4/PCE-PWD-Accts/2020-21/128 dated 12-05-2020 published in the Official Gazette on 21st May, 2020 and Notification No. 8-4/CE-PWD-Accts/2020-21/640 dated 30-08-2021 published in the Official Gazette on 9th September, 2021.

And whereas Government has decided to introduce 2 new categories of water supply consumers viz., Semi-Domestic Consumers (SDC) and Home Stays.

Now Government of Goa hereby introduces the water tariff for Semi-Domestic Consumers (SDC) and water tariff billed for Small Hotels & Restaurants, Hostels having number of rooms less than 15/Government tourist hostels (Non Air-Conditioned) having area upto 150 sq. mts. be made applicable to Home Stays and be billed as per the water supply tariff as under:

		as applicable to Domestic Consumers will be made applicable to this category with additional tariff of Rs. 300 per rented premises irrespective of its occupancy.
		<i>Note:</i> In order to avail the benefits of common domestic water connection tariff, to two or more house/flats/duplexes, the consumer will require to avail house numbers to each extended rental dwelling units.
2.	Small Hotels & Restaurants, Hostels having number of rooms less than 15/ Government tourist hostels (Non Air-Conditioned) having area upto 150 sq.mts and Home Stays.	Rs. 25 per m3 for 1st 80 m3. Rs. 30 per m3 above 80 m3. Contract Demand or 10m3 per month which-ever is higher.

Whereas the water supply tariff to all the categories of the consumers are to be billed as per Notification No. 8-4/PCE-PWD-Accts/2020-21/128 dated 12-05-2020 published in the Official Gazette on 21st May, 2020 and Notification No. 8-4/CE-PWD-Accts/2020-21/640 dated 30-08-2021 published in the Official Gazette on 9th September, 2021.

And whereas as per Note (5) of the Notification No. 8-4/PCE-PWD-Accts/2020-21/128 dated 12-05-2020, the water supply tariff

was to be increased by 5% at the beginning of each financial year and the same was not implemented till date.

Now, therefore it is decided that the water supply tariff be increased by 5% w.e.f 1st October, 2022 and thereafter at the beginning of each financial year.
