**Draft Amendments to the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Rules.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 479, Home (Transport-V), 21st August 2024,

No. SRO A-17/2024.—The following draft amendment to the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, which is proposed to be made in exercise of the powers conferred by section 65 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), is hereby published for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required under sub-section (1) of Section 212 of the said Act.

2. Notice is hereby given that the draft amendment will be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of thirty days from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received from any person with respect thereto before the date of expiry of the aforesaid period will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu.

3. Objection or suggestion, if any, should be addressed in duplicate to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Home, Prohibition and Excise Department, Secretariat, Chennai- 600 009.

**DRAFT AMENDMENTS.**

In the said Rules, in rule 116-B,-

(1) in sub-rule (7), for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

“(a) must have adequate open space or shed, measuring a minimum of 1.5 metre x 2.5 metre for two wheelers, a minimum of 3.0 metre x 5.5 metre for Light Motor Vehicles three wheelers and four wheelers (including two wheelers) and a minimum of 3 Metre X 8 metre for all other remaining categories of Vehicles, exclusively for carrying out the test. The premises of the emission test station shall be either owned or hired by the applicant in his name”;

(2) in sub-rule (8), for clause (iv), the following clause “shall be substituted, namely:-

“(iv) that the premises where the testing station has been set up is either owned or hired by the applicant in his name and has adequate open space or shed, measuring a minimum of 1.5 metre x 2.5 metre for two wheelers, a minimum of 3.0 metre x 5.5 meter for Light Motor Vehicles three wheelers and four wheelers (including two wheelers) and a minimum 3 metre x 8 metre for all other remaining categories of vehicles, exclusively for carrying out jobs connected with repairs of vehicles in addition to the infrastructure for keeping the equipments and office building; and”.
