2. This Notification shall come into force with effect on and from the date of its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

**Explanations.- (1) Dearness Allowance.-** In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages fixed above, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as indicated below:-

- (i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Consumer Price Index of Chennai City for the year 2010, that is 161 points (with base 2001=100) and for any further raise of every one point over and above 161 points, an increase of Rs.40.18 (Rupees forty and paise eighteen only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.
- (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the first April on the basis of the average of the consumer price indices for the preceding 12 months, that is from January to December; and
- (iii) The first calculation of the dearness allowance shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, based on the average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the previous year, that is from January to December.
