9.1 Subsidy pattern for Storage Infrastructure Projects:

9.1.1 Capital cost of the project for the purpose of subsidy will be calculated on the project cost as appraised by financial institution or actual cost of eligible components as certified by a Chartered Accountant, whichever is lower subject to the maximum capacity ceiling & maximum subsidy ceiling given below:

9.2 - Subsidy pattern for other than Storage Infrastructure Projects remains the same as earlier.

However, for integrated projects comprising of both storage as well as other than storage infrastructure projects promoted as a single project, the maximum subsidy shall be restricted to Rs. 75.00 Lakhs (for 25% category) and Rs. 100.00 lakhs (for 33.33% category) as the case may be, subject to revised overall subsidy ceiling at Para 9.3.1 as under:

9.3.1 Overall subsidy ceiling

In other than North Eastern States:

If a promoter has availed subsidy for 10,000 MT capacity storage infrastructure projects since last 10 years in the same District, he/she will not be eligible for any more subsidy

If a promoter has not availed subsidy for 10,000 MT capacity storage infrastructure projects since last 10 years in the same District, he/ she may avail subsidy for the balance capacity of storage infrastructure projects up to 2025-26 with a maximum subsidy ceiling of Rs. 150.00 lakhs (for promoters eligible for 25% subsidy) or Rs. 200.00 lakhs (for promoters eligible for 33.33% subsidy), including the subsidy already availed since last 10 years

The promoter shall submit an undertaking to this effect that he/ she has not availed subsidy for 10,000 MT capacity storage infrastructure projects since last 10 years in the same District

If a promoter has not availed subsidy for any storage as well as other than storage infrastructure projects since last 10 years, and intends to avail subsidy both for storage (upto 5,000 MT) as well as other than storage infrastructure projects as separate projects in the same District, he/ she will be eligible for a maximum subsidy up to Rs. 100.00 lakh (for promoters eligible for 25% subsidy) or Rs. 130.00 lakh (for promoters eligible for 33.33% subsidy), as the case may be

The promoter shall submit an undertaking to this effect that he/ she has not availed subsidy for any storage as well as other than storage infrastructure project since last 10 years

In North Eastern States:

If a promoter has availed subsidy for 10,000 MT capacity storage infrastructure projects since last 10 years in the same District, he/she will not be eligible for any more subsidy.

If a promoter has not availed subsidy for 10,000 MT capacity storage infrastructure projects since last 10 years in the same District, he/ she may avail subsidy for the balance capacity of storage infrastructure projects up to 2025-26 with a maximum subsidy ceiling of Rs. 266.64 lakhs (@ 33.33% subsidy), including the subsidy already availed since last 10 years

The promoter shall submit an undertaking to this effect that he/ she has not availed subsidy for 10,000 MT capacity storage infrastructure projects since last 10 years in the same District

If a promoter has not availed subsidy for any storage as well as other than storage infrastructure projects since last 10 years, and intends to avail subsidy both for storage (upto 5,000 MT) as well as other than storage infrastructure projects as separate projects in the same District, he/ she will be eligible for a maximum subsidy up to Rs. 163.32 lakh (@ 33.33% subsidy)

The promoter shall submit an undertaking to this effect that he/ she has not availed subsidy for any storage as well as other than storage infrastructure project since last 10 years
