The Labour Department hosted a press briefing today at the conference hall in Shram Bhawan, Sokaythang, with the primary objective of raising awareness about registration of workers in both organised and unorganised sectors under the Sikkim Labour (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 2021.
